Airport Transportation

Gimhae International Airport (PUS) is located on the western end of Busan. The airport fields flights around the country as well as regular international flights, mostly to/from Japan (Tokyo, Osaka, Fukuoka, Nagoya, and Sapporo) and China (Shanghai, Beijing, Qinhdao, Hong Kong, Shenyang, Guanzhou, Weihei, and Sanya). From other countries, you can transit at Incheon international airport (ICN) or Gimpo airport (GMP), both near Seoul.

Ground Transportation

Ground transportation between Gimhae airport and the Westin Chosun Hotel Busan is via “**Airport Limousine Bus**” or a taxi. The airport limousine bus (**No. 2, “Haeundae” Route**) departs every 20 minutes and it takes about 60 minutes between the airport and the hotel, depending on the traffic. The fare of the Airport Limousine Bus is flat 6,000 KRW (~ 5 USD) per single trip. Please refer to the following time table.

If you choose to take a taxi, the fare between the airport and the hotel would be around 25,000 KRW (~22 USD) with a regular taxi (various colors) or around 40,000 KRW (~36 USD) with a larger deluxe taxi (black body and yellow cap).

Meeting Registration Fees (per each participant)

Due to the extended meeting period, we regret to say that there will be a minimal registration fee per each participant. The amount of the registration fee is;

- **Early registration fee : 107 USD** on or before June 8, 2010 (EST)
- **Late registration fee : 135 USD** after June 8, 2010 (EST)
- **Cancellation charge : 25 USD** for the cancellation received after June 8, 2010 (EST)

The registration fee should be paid via a valid credit card through the meeting registration website to be kindly provided by IEEE-SA. IEEE-SA will issue a receipt for each payment. Please note the registration website will be open for a while even after the meeting starts, but all the participants are recommended to register online in advance, to alleviate the host’s workload.

Room Reservation

Room Rates

The special discounted room rate is **200,000 KRW** (~175 USD) per night for a single/double occupancy. The rate includes daily breakfasts for one person, 10% service charge, and 11% tax. You can choose options such as ocean view, room type, and additional breakfast (refer to the room reservation form for the rates of such options).

Visa

Car Rental

We do not recommend a car rental. Driving in the city is not convenient due to common traffic jams. You can easily access to the subway (Dongbaek station, Line 2) near the hotel.

Tipping

In Korea, tipping is neither customary, nor expected.

Language

Koreans speak *Korean* with our own alphabet system, *Hangul*. Hangul is a phonemic alphabet and if you want to learn how it is organized and pronounced, refer to Annex B.

Weather of Busan

Temperatures for Busan at that time of the year are 18-25°C, 64-77°F in average. Monsoon season in Korea usually starts at the end of June, but it will be a good idea to carry an umbrella.
